Drum Recycling Program Procedures and Costs Outline

At Jamestown we recognize that drum recycling is an important concern to many of our customers. As such, Jamestown will now be working with our independent trucking companies and drum refurbishing firms to provide this important service at a very economical price. To make this service is fair to all of our customers, especially the ones that make their own arrangements for drum disposal, Jamestown will now implement the following minimal charges for our recycling services:

<u>Package Size:</u>	<u>Disposal Cost</u>
275 gallon tote	\$25.00 each
55 and 30 gallon drums	\$15.00 each
15 and 5 gallon pails	\$ 5.00 each

Customers will also be responsible for freight charges incurred for delivery to the drum reconditioning company.

Under this program it will primarily be the responsibility of the Jamestown Sales Representative to monitor the number of empty drums currently on-hand at the account and to coordinate the Recycling Program. Depending upon the size of the account, drum recycling should be scheduled on a regular quarterly or semi-annual basis. Under no circumstances should an excessively large number of drums be allowed to accumulate at an account. Also, Jamestown reserves the right to refuse recycling services at accounts where the drums have been stored for long periods of time, are not fitted and sealed with both bungs, are excessively dirty, do not include the original product labels, or still contain residual amounts of unused chemicals. Ideally, all drums should be triple-rinsed with tap water before recycling to insure that they are clean. Jamestown will also not recycle drums from other chemical vendors. Jamestown also recommends a minimum of 10 drums and/or 2 totes for a scheduled recycling pick-up.

To schedule drum recycling at an account, simply contact your Jamestown Representative directly and give them the relevant information, including the size and number of drums to be included in the pick-up, what chemical was previously shipped in the drum, and the correct pick-up address. Please insure that the drums are clean and in the proper location when the truck arrives for the scheduled pick-up. Allow up to 10 business days for Jamestown to work with our vendors to complete the recycling program at your facility.
